

Model GMPC Green Machine Pro® Fertilizer Caddy® Installation, Operation and Maintenance

Fertilizer must be in liquid form when it's poured into the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy. If using a premixed liquid, usually you can pour it in full strength. If using a dry, totally water soluble granular fertilizer such as Scotts Miracle Gro® or Peters Professional®, Bandini Pro Choice®, or Grow More®, premix with water at a ratio of 1 to 1-1/4 pound of dry formula (i.e. one small bag of Miracle Grow® general purpose plant food, 15-15-15) to 1 gallon of water. Fish emulsion or any petroleum-based additives can only be used in the Fertilizer Caddy if they have been premixed with water at a 1 to 1 ratio. Read and follow the manufacturer's directions printed on the fertilizer container. When using the Fertilizer Caddy as an injector, you may also want to consider adding a wetting agent, like Grow More E-Z Wet Soil Penetrant 26® to help breakup compacted soils, compost tea to increase micro-organisms in the soil, micro-nutrients or Vitamin Institute's SUPERthrive™ containing vitamins and hormones for healthier plants, or vitamin B-1 when transplanting trees and shrubs. Usually, 1 gallon of liquid fertilizer will cover approximately 1,000 square feet. When using the Fertilizer Caddy as a foliage feeder, only place a liquid solution of fertilizer inside the additive tank, no other additive!

To initially fill the Fertilizer Caddy, remove the top fill cap. Insert a fill funnel into the opening and pour in liquid solution. Fill the tank completely. Replace the cap and the Fertilizer Caddy is ready for operation. Turn on the irrigation system. Consult the chart below to determine how many gallons of water need to pass through the irrigation system in order to empty the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy. For example, let's say that you've installed the half-gallon capacity unit and the irrigation system is operating at a flow rate of 3 gallons per minute (GPM). After consulting the chart below, you know it will take 100 gallons of water passing through the injector to empty it. Divide this number by the flow rate of 3 GPM. You now know it will take a little over half an hour (30 minutes) to not only water your trees, shrubs and lawn, etc., but also fertilize them as well. Before pressurizing the injector, **always** be sure that the unit is completely full of either additive or water.

When the time comes to refill the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy, simply turn off the incoming water supply. Remove both the end drain cap and the top fill cap. Allow all of the water to drain from the unit and replace the end drain cap. Place a fill funnel in the top opening and recharge the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy. Replace the top fill cap and turn on the irrigation system. Once you have completed watering, it is not necessary to drain the unit. If there is fertilizer or additive still in the tank, it will be dispensed the next time you operate your irrigation system. If all of the additive has been dispensed, it will not harm the unit to have water running through it when you are not fertilizing. On the contrary, the clear water passing through the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy will help keep it clean inside. Fertilize as often as recommended by the fertilizer manufacturer during the growing season. For optimum plant growth and health, we recommend that you use the Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy as a foliage feeder on a monthly basis as well.

The Green Machine Pro Fertilizer Caddy can be left outside. However, it is recommended that you either cover the unit to protect it from the elements, bury it in a valve box, or paint it with either an aerosol paint or a water-based acrylic latex house paint. This will add to the longevity of the unit, especially if it is left out year round. If you choose to leave the unit outside during the winter months, and there is a possibility of freezing in your area, it is highly recommended that the unit be left drained and vented to atmosphere to prevent damage.
